Dress Code

Students at Sacred Heart School shall wear clothing that exemplifies Christian values and modesty at all times. Students are expected to wear appropriate clothing (advertising for alcohol, drugs, bars, etc. or that which is deemed offensive are not allowed). The administration will be the final judge on what is appropriate dress. Guidelines for appropriate dress consist of (but are not limited to):

Shirts

No midriffs, cleavage or undergarments may be shown at any time. This includes underwear style tank tops.

Sleeveless shirts are permitted, but spaghetti straps and cut-off t-shirts are not allowed.

No holes are allowed.

Bottoms

Shorts and skorts are permitted beginning April 1st and ending September 30th on normal dress days. Skirts are permitted year-round, but must have tights or leggings underneath beginning October 1st and ending March 31st.

The administration has the power to change these dates in accordance to the weather.

Shorts, skorts and skirts should extend midway between the hip and knee.

No holes are allowed.

Additional Guidelines

No outerwear is permitted during school hours (winter coats, rain coats, hats, gloves, etc.).

Distracting hairstyles or colors are not permitted.

Mass Dress

Students are to wear a Sacred Heart School collared shirt, tucked in.

Solid-colored dress pants, dress shorts, skorts or skirts may be worn (the April 1st through September 30th dates still apply).

No jeans/denim are allowed on Mass days.
